WHAT HAPPENS IN OUR PORTRAITS OF CHANGE?

EPISODE 01

MADE IN INDONESIA

- Focuses on approaching the ocean plastic problem.
- We meet Ica, an ocean plastic activist and community leader at MBRC® the ocean.
- Ica and MBRC® the ocean support local communities in Labuan Bajo to collect plastic and build a full waste management system.
- The episode is about education, more awareness and getting actively involved.

EPISODE 02

MADE IN PAKISTAN

- Shows how an innovative mindset can change the denim industry.
- We meet Arsal, the founder of Denim Privé.
- Arsal and his team constantly come up with new water-saving washes, treatments and production processes.
- The episode is about sustainable thinking, ecological responsibility and challenging the status quo.

EPISODE 03

MADE IN BANGLADESH

- Is about realizing one's potential and encouraging others to do so too.
- We meet Jesmin, a female supervisor.
- Jesmin joined the Female Supervisor Leadership Programme in her factory and got promoted.
- The episode is about self-worth, gender equality and empowering each other in the community.
